Overview of the Islamic Essentials Course

This two-year Islamic course is specifically designed for brothers and sisters wishing to study core Islamic subjects. Delivered in English, this comprehensive course will equip mature students with knowledge and deep understanding of Islam. Certification will be provided upon the completion of this course.

The course content has been carefully selected so that key topics are studied and essential subjects covered in a short period of time. The course will be delivered once a week for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

Lessons are delivered in English and will cover the study of the following subjects:

- Translation and Commentary of the Holy Qur'an
- Study of Fiqh
- Understanding of Aqaaid and Beliefs

On completion of this course students will have attained a sound understanding of the core tenets of Islam, which will equip them to meet the challenges of modern-day life as a Muslim without compromising their religion.

The course will help Muslim brothers and Sisters to learn about Islam from a foundation level to a higher level providing them with knowledge and understanding of Islam. This will enable students to conduct their life in accordance with the commands of Allah and the Sunnah of His Prophet ^{##}

We understand the demands of modern life and the busy lifestyle we live so we have deliberately kept lessons short but focused and rich but not overwhelming, ensuring that only very limited study outside of lessons is required.

By the end of the course students will have the satisfaction of practicing their Deen with the knowledge from the Qur'an and the Sunnah together with the ability to understand and translate parts of the Holy Qur'an and the Prophetic Hadith from Arabic.

Course Outline

Module 1

Qur'an Tafseer				
Tafsīr is the subject which deals with the interpretation and clear understanding of the verses of the Qur'ān.				
Book	Qur'an Made Easy – Arabic Text with English Translation			
Objective	An introduction to the science of the Qur'an followed by the study of the English translation of the last 20 surahs of the Qur'an with brief commentary and more.			

Module 2

Fiqh				
Figh is the study of Islamic law. This law is derived from four primary sources: the Holy				
Qur'ān, sayings of the Prophet ³⁴ , the consensus of the jurists and legal analogy.				
Book	- Ascent to Felicity			
Objective	Study the necessary Islamic Jurisprudence relating to the laws of purification followed by Salah, Zakat, Fasting & Hajj and more.			

Module 3

Aqida				
Aqīdah is the science that details the Muslim creed which are known through revelation and must be believed in with conviction. The acceptance of all actions is dependent on having the correct beliefs.				
Book	- Al-Aqida al-Tahawiyya - English translation with explanations of the key articles of faith.			
Objective	To learn the important tenets of creed that differentiates between Ahle al- Sunnah wa al-Jama'ah from others as explained in Al-Aqida al- Tahawiyya. To examine the basis of the Ahle al-Sunnah creedal positions based upon the Qur'an and Sunnah.			

Who is the Target Audience for this Course?

This course is ideal for brothers and sisters who wish to acquaint themselves with the foundations of Islamic studies. It is an opportunity for students who have completed the Maktab syllabus and wish to progress further in learning Islamic studies.

Classes will take place on Wednesdays 9:30am -11am for sisters only And 7:30pm – 9pm for brothers & sisters

2 years of study. This course runs during school term times only. The academic year will commence in September and end in July.
